



## What is an **Interior Designer?**

Interior designers plan, design and supervise the construction of the inside of residential and commercial buildings to make rooms and spaces functional, safe and visually appealing.

## What does the **job involve?**

- **Understanding** the design requirements by working with clients and contractors
- **Researching** and analysing design features, including functionality, efficiency, safety and visual requirements
- **Developing** design concepts, including preparing sketches, diagrams, illustrations and plans
- **Negotiating** with clients, management, suppliers and construction staff
- **Selecting** and recommending interior materials, furniture and other products
- **Liaising** with the project manager during construction of interiors

## How do I get into **this career?**

Undertake a qualification in interior design. This may be via a vocational pathway or as an undergraduate, supported by experience working in a design role. A high level of creativity and pursuing further study such as a Master of Design, may also give you an advantage.
